OOMCO and Wakud sign agreement to introduce Biodiesel in Oman

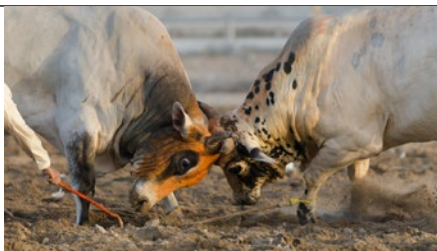
